Applications are invited for the following post mentioned below, under the extramural project "SOCIO-CULTURAL DETERMINANTS, COMMUNITY AWARENESS, TREATMENT AND REHABILITATION OF PATIENTS OF SUBSTANCE USE DISORDER (SUD) IN ASSAM AND ARUNACHAL PRADESH" implemented by Department of Sociology, Dibrugarh University, Dibrugarh, Assam under ICMR- New Delhi.

- o Name of the Position: Project Technical Support-I: 01 (One post)
- Place of Work: 4 districts out of 8 study districts: 6 districts of Assam (Dibrugarh, Tinsukia, Cachar, Kamrup (Metro), Nagaon, Karimganj) and 2 districts of Arunachal Pradesh (Namsai, Changlang)
- Essential qualification and experience: Graduate Degree in Sociology and Social Work. Candidates with Post-Graduation in relevant subject/field and candidates with relevant work on substance use during coursework shall be preferred. Candidates with working knowledge of computers and fluency in the local languages spoken in Arunachal Pradesh and Assam would be given preference.
- O **Monthly Consolidated Emoluments:** Rs. 18,000/- per month + 9% HRA = Rs. 19,620 per month.
- O **Upper age –limit for fresh recruits:** 30 years
