**COMMON ADMISSION TEST (CAT) of Dibrugarh University  
For Admission into Five Year Integrated BALLB (Honours)/ BBALLB  
(Honours)/BBALLB (Non Honours) Programme  
SESSION: 2026-2027**

Online applications are invited from eligible candidates for appearing in the Common Admission Test,2026 for admission in to the Five Year Integrated BALLB (Honours), BBALLB(Honours) and BBALLB(Non Honours)Programme for the academic Session 2026-2027 at Centre for Juridical Studies, Dibrugarh University and Affiliated Law Colleges of Dibrugarh University. All eligible candidates intending to get admission into the BA/BBALLB (Honours) and BBALLB (Non Honours) Programme offered by the Centre For Juridical Studies at Dibrugarh University Campus and affiliated Colleges ( Dr.R.K.B Law College, SIPE Law College, Jorhat Law College, Golaghat Law College and NERIM Law College, Guwahati ) shall require to appear and qualify in the Common Admission Test,2026.At present Total intake of seats are:

**Eligibility for Admission:** A candidate for admission into the Five Year Integrated BA/BBALLB(Honours)/BBALLB(Non-Honours)Programme should have passed the Higher Secondary Examination (10+2) or an equivalent examination securing at least 45% in aggregate of the total marks. The candidates appearing in the final Examination of Higher Secondary (10 +2) level will also be provisionally eligible for appearing in the test and there shall be a relaxation of 5% marks for SC and ST applicants and 3% for OBC applicants. Provisionally allowed candidates must produce mark sheet and pass certificates of qualifying examination at the time of admission.

*(Any other issue of eligibility shall be decided as per BCI rules)*

### ***Admission Procedure:***

The admission into the aforesaid Programme(s) shall be allowed only on merit basis through the Common Admission Test to be conducted by the University. Admission cannot be claimed by any applicant as a matter of right. On being selected for admission, the applicant shall require to appear before Admission Committee at the Centre for Juridical Studies, Dibrugarh University and respective Colleges with all original certificates, Mark sheets and other requirements on scheduled date and time as per the notification to be published for the same separately. If any selected candidate fails to deposit prescribed admission fee within the stipulated time/ relevant marks sheet, certificates including PRC/ Provisional Certificate from the Local man in case of non availability of PRC / Caste certificates/OBC (Non Creamy Layer Certificate)/ EWS Certificate etc, as may be necessary, his/her admission shall automatically stand cancelled. The Affiliated Law Colleges shall also follow the said procedure for maintaining transparency in the process.

### ***Reservation***

- Statutory Reservation Policy of the Government of Assam with Dibrugarh University Rules shall be followed.

### ***Application Procedure***

1. Applications for appearing in the Common Admission Test for admission in to Five Year Integrated BA/BBALLB(Honours)/BBALLB(Non Honours)Programme shall be made through online mode only. No other means of applications shall be accepted.
2. Online Registration for submission of Application Form will begin from 11/05/2026. The last date for submission of application is 05/06/2026.
3. For submission of the *Online Application*, intending candidates shall follow the following instructions:
  - a. The candidate shall require to visit the Admission Portal in the Dibrugarh University website [www.dibru.ac.in](http://www.dibru.ac.in).
  - b. The Candidate shall register on the portal by clicking the "Register" button by mentioning his/her name, mobile number and a password. The mobile number will be verified through an OTP. Please keep the password for login. The mobile number registered shall be used for future correspondence, as and when necessary and the mobile number should be in working mode.
  - c. After successful registration, the candidate needs to login using his/her mobile number and the password.
  - d. After login, the candidate needs to click on the "Apply" button corresponding to the link of "Common Admission Test for BA/BBA LLB(Honours) and BBALLB(Non-Honours) " which will generate an application form. *The candidate needs to fill up the application form step by step carefully.*
  - e. After completion of the filling-up of the form, Candidate needs to click the button "Submit and Review". A preview of the filled-up form will

be displayed. Candidates are advised to carefully cross-check the information and if anything needs to be corrected at this stage, they can go back and edit.

- f. After ensuring that all information displayed on the Preview is correct, the candidate needs to click 'Pay now & Submit the application" and then pay the application fee of Rs. 1000/- (Rupees one thousand) only through online mode (Debit Card/Credit Card/Internet Banking/UPI).
- g. The application form will be considered as finally submitted only when the application fee is successfully paid by the candidate and an online receipt is generated confirming the payment. Once submitted, the application form cannot be edited by the applicant afterwards.
- h. There will be a button to download the Application Form for future reference.
- i. Admit Cards will be generated only a few days prior to the date of the Test. Once generated, candidates will be able to download their Admit Cards from the same portal by logging in with their credentials. A notification regarding the generation and availability of Admit Cards on the portal will be published in the Dibrugarh University website.
- j. *The Candidate shall have to take a print out of the Admit Card and bring the same to the Examination Hall on the Date of the Test for verification*
- k. Only one application shall be submitted by one candidate.
- l. No individual letter(s) will be issued and sent to the candidates regarding the admission process. Candidates shall visit the University website [www.dibru.ac.in](http://www.dibru.ac.in) for any relevant information.

**Important Note:**

The candidates are advised to ensure eligibility before applying for the Admission Test. It be noted that appearance in the Admission Test shall not entitle applicants to claim admission, if minimum eligibility norms are not fulfilled by him/her at the time of admission.

**Method of Answering In the Common Admission Test (CAT):**

At the beginning of the test, the applicants shall be provided a Question-cum-Answer Booklet containing 50 (Fifty) Multiple-Choice Questions. The candidate shall check the Question Booklet to ensure that it contains all pages in sequence and no question(s)/page(s) is/are missing from the booklet. If the Question Booklet is found defective, the candidate shall promptly inform the invigilator who will provide him/her fresh Question-cum-Answer Booklet. The candidate shall fill-up basic information on the Question- cum-Answer Booklet at proper places before responding to questions.

Each question shall have four suggestive answers- A, B, C, D of which only one is correct. The correct answer shall be responded through tick mark [✓] with black/blue ball point pen only. **USE OF PENCIL IS NOT PERMITTED.** Making ticks in more than one options against any question shall be treated as wrong answer. The applicants shall not be allowed to take Question- cum-Answer Booklet with them. At the end of the Test, the Question –cum- Answer Booklet shall be returned to the invigilator. No page(s) from the Question –cum- Answer Booklet is to be expunged or removed. If a candidate attempts/ found involved in removing any page from the Question –cum-Answer Booklet, his/her candidature shall be cancelled.

**Evaluation and Result:**

Each question will of two marks. There shall be no negative marking for wrong answer. The University shall display result of the Common Admission Tests on the University website. No other mode of publication of result shall be adopted. In case of equal marks in Admission Test, the preference will be given to the candidate with higher marks in the qualifying examination for the purpose of admission.

**Medium of instruction:**

The medium of instruction shall be English.

**Instructions for Applicants:**

- The applicant shall reach at Admission Test Centre with Admit Card preferably before 30 minutes of scheduled time.
- After 15 minutes of commencement of the Test, no applicant shall be allowed to enter into the Examination Hall.
- No applicant shall be allowed to leave the Examination Hall except in case of any emergency with permission of the invigilators.
- Adopting unfair means during Test will attract penal actions. In the Examination Hall, talking with other candidates, use of prohibited materials, use of mobiles /electronic devices, tampering with Admit Cards, canvassing in any form are **STRICTLY PROHIBITED.**  
**MOBILES / SMART PHONES/SMART WATCHES/ BLUETOOTH / ELECTRONIC DEVICES / GADGETS ETC. IN the EXAMINATION HALL ARE TOTALLY PROHIBITED.** The applicants are directed not to bring their mobiles/Bluetooth/any other electronic devices or electronic appliances/gadgets into the examination hall.
- Any candidate during test, may be checked by invigilator or by any authorized person.

- Except the authorized person of the University/ Centre for the purpose of Test, no one shall move around the Entrance Test venue during the examination.
- Application Forms of those applicants who have submitted forged/fake mark sheet /certificates or adopted fraudulent means shall be **REJECTED** without any formal notice and the concerned applicant(s)/ candidate(s) shall be debarred from appearing in any entrance test of the University.
- Candidates are allowed to appear in the Admission Test provisionally which is subject to final verification of all original certificates/mark sheets/caste certificates etc.
- Permission for appearing in the Common Admission Test shall not entitle an applicant/candidate to claim for admission as a matter of right, if he/she does not fulfill all required criteria prescribed by the University as per Rules & Norms.
- The University/College shall cancel admission of any candidate at any stage, if it is found at any time during admission/after admission in to the Programme that, the applicant has not fulfilled minimum eligibility norms as per Rules or submitted false/ fabricated documents.
- **SCRUTINY/REVALUATION OF ANSWER SHEETS OF THE ADMISSION TEST IS NOT ALLOWED UNDER ANY CIRCUMSTANCE(S). COPY OF ANSWERS SCRIPTS SHALL NOT BE PROVIDED TO ANY CANDIDATE UNDER ANY CIRCUMSTANCES.**
- The decision of the CAT,2026 Committee shall be binding on any dispute, if raised within one month from the publication of the result.
