Admission Modalities

The details of Eligibility Criteria, Online Application Procedure and Admission Modalities etc. are given below:

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

A minimum of 60% aggregate percentage of marks or equivalent grade in (10+2) examination for General Category and 55% aggregate percentage of marks or equivalent grade in (10+2) examination for the SC/ST/OBC/EWS/PWD candidates will be considered as eligibility criterion.

ONLINE APPLICATION PROCEDURE

Admission to the Five-Year Integrated Postgraduate Programme (FYIPGP) shall be provisioned through the Assam Higher Education Admission Portal (<https://assamadmission.samarth.ac.in>). The candidates are advised to register in the above portal and apply for admission.

ADMISSION MODALITIES

For admission into the Five-Year Integrated Postgraduate Programme (FYIPGP) of Dibrugarh University, the following two criteria shall be followed:

Criterion 1(a):

90% of the total seats in each Department of Dibrugarh University shall be filled up on the basis of merit in the (10+2) examination conducted by the recognized boards as per clause 4 below. Under this criterion,



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- i. The aggregate percentage of marks or equivalent grade in (10+2) examination will be considered for eligibility criterion,

Criterion 1(b):

1. Remaining 10% of the seats in each Department of Dibrugarh University shall be filled up based on the performance of the candidates in the Common University Entrance Test for Under Graduate (CUET-UG 2025) programmes in the relevant discipline conducted by National Testing Agency (NTA).
2. A minimum of 60% aggregate percentage of marks or equivalent grade in (10+2) examination for General Category and 55% aggregate percentage of marks or equivalent grade in (10+2) examination for the SC/ST/OBC/EWS/PWD candidates will be considered as eligibility criterion.
3. Statutory Reservation Policy shall be followed as per the Government Rules by the University while preparing the Merit List of the candidates.
4. The merit list will be prepared centrally considering the order of preference of the candidates.
5. Under criterion 1(a),
 - i. In case of two or more candidates securing an equal aggregate percentage of marks or grade in the (10+2) examination, the candidate securing higher percentage of marks in the subject opting for Major in the (10+2) examination shall be ranked higher in the allotment of Major.
 - i. In case of two or more candidates securing equal aggregate percentage of marks in the (10+2) examination as well as equal percentage of marks in the (10+2) examination in the subject opting for Major, the candidates securing higher aggregate percentage of marks/grade in class 10 shall be ranked higher in the allotment of Major in the subject.
6. If any seat remains vacant under either of the above two criteria (1(a) or 1(b)), the same may be filled from the eligible candidates through alteration.
7. If a candidate is eligible for admission into a program under both criteria 1(a) and 1(b), he/she shall be admitted through criterion 1(a) only.
8. For any matter not covered by the above clauses, the decision of the Competent Authority shall be final and binding.



Admission Schedule

- a. Admission to all the Departments/Centres of Studies shall be held centrally. The Schedule and Procedure for admission shall be notified on the website: **www.dibru.ac.in** along with the List of the Provisionally Selected Candidates prepared by the Admission Committee of the Department/Centre of Studies.
- b. The admission and other fees to be paid at the time of admission shall be received through online payment system. The University shall guide the candidates for payment of their fees.
